

The Red Cross is working with hospitals around the clock to meet the blood needs of patients - but can't do it alone. We need your help!

Sign Up for Synod Small Groups





Fall Speaker Event: "Fear of Beggars and Love of Neighbor"

How should Christians think about encounters with panhandlers and the poor? The Center for Catholic Social Thought is pleased to announce two upcoming lectures on this topic entitled, "Fear of Beggars and Love of Neighbor: A Spirituality of the Common Good for Our Streets," by Professor Kelly Johnson. There is one lecture on Friday, October 18, at 6:30pm and another the next day, Saturday, October 19, at 10am, both here at Assumption. Dr. Johnson is Professor of Theology and Social Justice at Dayton University in Ohio and writes widely on Catholic Social Teaching.
