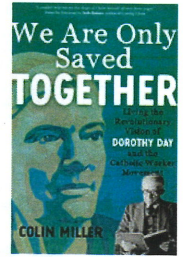


## Upcoming Events

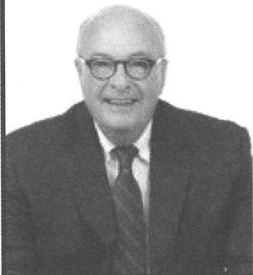

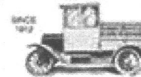

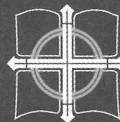
